

The Detroit MSA is **15th** in the nation for job postings






Michigan Can't Be Left Behind

in the nation for student share of college tuition






Top 15 States by Higher Education Attainment and GDP Per Capita




Odds are **five times** greater for the poorest Detroit residents to rise from poverty with a postsecondary education

What the Chamber Is Doing: Policy Agenda




Connect adult workers with postsecondary credentials in high-demand fields




